Heads or Tails raffle rules

Participants pay a fee to play and receive a string of beads which identifies them as a player.

When the game begins, all bead-wearing participants are standing. The MC asks all participants to put their hands on their head, or their... uh, tail prior to a coin toss. You can't change your mind once you've chosen, and you can't put your hands on anybody else's head (or tail).

The MC flips a coin and announces the outcome. If it's Heads, all those with hands on their heads stay standing, if it's Tails, those who chose that option stay in the game. Others either sit down or are out of the game or may surrender a string of beads to remain in the game.

Those still standing again choose heads or tails, and the coin tosses continue until only one person is left standing.

Beads may be purchased from the registration desk or a Board Member for:

- 1 string for \$5
- 2 strings for \$10
- 3 strings for \$15
- 5 strings for \$20
